**ORDER**

This matter came before a single justice of this Court, sitting as Duty Justice, on the petitioner's "Emergency Motion to Stay". The respondent filed an "Objection and Memorandum in Opposition of Petitioner's Motion to Stay". Upon consideration of the filings, the following is ordered:

The emergency motion for stay is granted, with the following conditions, pending review by the full Court at its conference on September 8, 2022:

- (a) The petitioner shall not have live music performed at Ballard's Inn;
- (b) The petitioner shall not do any paid advertising for any music to be offered at Ballard's Inn during the remainder of the season;
- (c) The petitioner shall have at least four (4) security guards on weekdays and seven (7) security guards on weekends, all of whom shall be wearing identifiable "security" clothing, and, further, the petitioner shall coordinate with the Town of New Shoreham with respect to providing appropriate crowd control and sufficient security.
